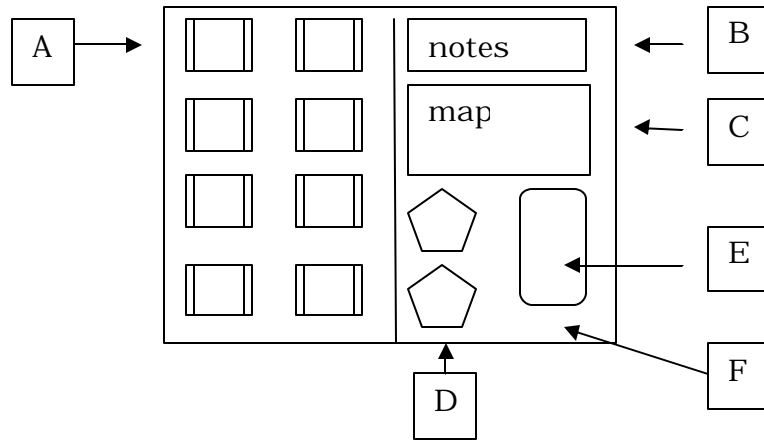


## Native American Lap Book Project

You will create a Native American lap book using the directions below:



- A) On the left hand side, complete the eight flipbooks on the societies of North America. Use the information shared from group work to complete this.
- B) On the right hand side at the top, glue in the attached notes on Native American Diversity.
- C) Color in the attached map to match the regions on the left hand side. Be sure to color in the legend on the map. Glue this map in below the notes.
- D) Below the map will be a section called Guess the Tribes. Using information from the following website,

create two petal pentagon puzzles. Each pentagon will contain clues to the name of a tribe. After cutting out the petal pentagons, fold the “petals” in. you should have a pentagon shape. On the outside is the item you should give a clue for on the inside. Write the clue on the inside of the petal. In the center of the pentagon, draw a picture of the style home that tribe lived in. Glue each pentagon into the lap book as shown above. Next to the top one, write Tribe A. Write Tribe B next to the bottom one. The pentagons should be from two different regions.

- E) Next to the pentagons you will cut out and glue in the answer pocket. Write the answers to your tribes on a piece of paper and stick it in the pocket.
- F) Below the answer pocket write your name and homeroom.
- G) Finally, write the title Native Americans of North America on the cover and decorate the cover appropriately.
- H) You will be graded according to the attached rubric. This will be considered an individual project and be worth 30% in the weighted scale for your quarter grade.
