Dear Parents and/or Guardians;

In 2006, one of our parishioners, Cletus A. Vogel, left a bequest to St. Teresa Parish to help students attend Catholic high schools and colleges. The Vogel Family Educational Fund will be dispersed in scholarships to 8th grade graduates of St. Teresa School including those graduating in 2012. Students who will attend one of the following schools for the 2012-2013 school year are eligible to apply: Elder High School, Seton High School, Mother of Mercy High School, St. Xavier High School, Xavier University, or the College of Mount St. Joseph. Approximately \$100,000 will be awarded annually in scholarships with individual amounts ranging from \$700.00 - \$1,200.00.

This year your Federal Income Tax Form (1040) will not be necessary. The only requirement is the completed application. *Applications must be submitted to the parish or school office by March 5, 2012.* Fr. Bolte will review the applications and determine the recipients of the Vogel Family Educational Scholarships. A factor on the amount of the scholarships is the current involvement of the student in St. Teresa Parish: server, lector, Eucharistic Minister, volunteer with P.S.R. classes, etc. Hopefully, all who apply will receive a scholarship.

Recipients will be notified by March 12, 2012 if they have been selected to receive a scholarship. Recipients are also requested to attend mass at St. Teresa of Avila church the weekend of March 17-18 to be recognized by Father Bolte and to receive their scholarship. You must fill out a separate application for each child seeking a scholarship. In addition, **you must fill out a new application for each child every year.** Applications can be downloaded from the school's website at www.stteresa.net.
