

Dear Parents,

I am writing to ask your cooperation with two issues. We are getting inundated with parents bringing up lunches, school supplies, gym clothes or homework and asking us to deliver it to their child. I feel that we have been very lenient with this policy and unfortunately, it is getting worse. Some schools don't allow parents to bring up anything to school, including lunches. I ask your help in that you make every effort to ensure that your child has his/her lunch, school supplies, gym clothes and homework BEFORE you leave for school every morning. We ask that from now on, if your child forgets his/her schools supplies, gym clothes or homework that you allow your child to receive the consequences for this action rather than bringing it to school to "bail" him/her out. If you set the expectation with your child that you will not be bringing these items up to school, it will hopefully help your child to develop responsibility with these tasks.

Secondly, there are more and more students tardy every day. Today for example, there were 13 students tardy. Many days it is the same students tardy. We ask that you talk about your morning routine and come up with a plan that will enable you to get out the door early enough to give yourself EXTRA time in case you run into traffic. If you find that your child is tardy frequently, plan on arriving to school at 7:50 a.m. rather than 8:00 a.m. When a child is tardy, it really starts the day off poorly because they have to scramble to get their supplies for the day and then try to "catch up." It also places a burden on the teachers because they have to stop what they are doing and "catch" the child up. We are dedicated to doing everything we can to ensure the academic success of the students in our school. It is during the elementary school years that children establish important habits for learning as well as school attendance. We ask that you take all necessary steps to ensure that your child attends school, on time, daily.

Thank you for your assistance in the above matters and TOGETHER we can help your child succeed in school.
