Hello Bruin Families,

The letter today is for my 6th grade parents!

Tdap Booster and Meningococcal Vaccines

To our parents/guardians of incoming 7th graders - The Ohio Department of Health School Immunization Requirements now states that a student must be administered one dose of Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine and a dose of Tdap before entering the seventh grade. The Tdap is intended to be administered as a booster dose for students who have completed all the required doses of the initial series of DTaP/DT/Td.

Your student will need to show proof of receiving these vaccines before they return to school in the fall. If your child has not received these by August 31, 2021, they will be excluded from school.

If you choose to decline vaccinations for medical purposes, you must provide the school with a doctor signed declination form. If you object to immunizations for good cause, including religious convictions, an exemption form can be obtained through the school nurse and must be signed by you.

You are receiving this letter now to provide you with ample time to have your child immunized before the upcoming school year begins. Please contact your child's pediatrician or health department to schedule an appointment. If you need information about immunizations clinics, please contact me at gross_k@stteresa.net
