❖ With the change in the weather and April 15th approaching, we wanted to send out a few reminders concerning the dress code. Shorts may be worn beginning April 15th until the end of the school year. No visible tattoos (including temporary tattoos) or body piercing (except as noted for post earrings /girls only). Students are not to be writing on hands, arms, legs etc. Not only is it not part of the uniform policy, it also keeps teachers from worrying about answers being used for tests. We have seen an increase in the wearing of jewelry in the upper grades. One small post earring worn in the ear lobe per ear may be worn by the students. No hoop or dangling earrings for safety reasons. One watch, one ring, one simple chain necklace is acceptable. No bracelets are allowed except for the rubber bracelets (Maximum of 2). Excessive/distracting jewelry is unacceptable. Thank you for following the dress code requirements.

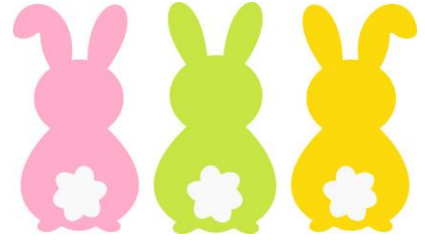
Around Town
